2010 STATUS ONE SCHOLARSHIP

Rules, Regulations, and Entry Requirements

Amount

\$500 awarded in the Fall Semester of the student's freshmen year of college.

Eligibility

This scholarship is open to students during their senior year of high school who are members in good standing of Iowa Community Credit Union. The student must be able to verify enrollment in a college, university, or trade school for the 2010 Fall Semester.

Entry Requirements:

1. Entrants will be required to write an essay of approximately 500 words on The topic, *“What makes a Credit Union better than other financial institutions and what role will it play in my financial career?”* A successful essay will not only explain credit union uniqueness to the applicant personally, but also the uniqueness of credit unions in the financial marketplace. The essay must be typed or computer printed and double spaced on white 8 ½ x 11 paper. The essay must be original work of the entrant. Entrants will be allowed to use credit union reference materials and contact credit union officials for background information.
2. Entrants will also be required to submit a business-style resume. This resume must also be typed or computer printed on white 8 ½ x 11 paper. The resume should not exceed two pages in length, and at a minimum should contain the following information: Entrant's name, address, phone number, educational information (including the high school attended), subjects emphasized throughout entrant's education, accumulative grade point average, ACT/SAT scores (if available), honors and awards, extracurricular activities, and future educational plans.
3. Entrants must complete and sign the entry form.
4. Applicants may be asked for a personal interview.

Basis of Selection

1. Essays will be judged on originality, clarity, meaningful content, accurate presentation of facts, adherence to contest rules, spelling, neatness, grammar, and punctuation.
2. Resumes will be judged on neatness, presentation, adherence to contest rules, and potential of the student to strive to be successful in college.
3. The following applications will also be taken into consideration as a whole: academic excellence and grade point average, leadership ability displaying well-roundedness exhibited through extracurricular activities and community involvement, and career plans and future goals.
4. All entries must be postmarked no later than March 15, 2010. Entries must be sent to:

2. The scholarship funds will be held by ICCU until written verification is received from the college registrar where the student is enrolled full-time. Upon written verification, the winner's share draft will be made payable to both the winner and the college.
